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Abstract:

This poster board presentation was prepared to share our research experiences with other peers. At the time of the poster board presentation, the University of the Pacific Invisalign Feasibility study was fully underway. Anecdotally, we were receiving reports that the Aligners were very comfortable and patients did not mind wearing them full time and even some patients liked wearing them full time. We designed a survey to explore these possibilities. Approximately 50 patients in the study were surveyed. All patients reported comfort and easy use of Aligners. Patients were asked if they had to repeat the process would they have braces or Invisalign again. All patients reported that they would not have braces, even those that were not yet fully satisfied with their treatment outcome. Those patients that had braces in the past (e.g. when they were young) had higher scores for comfort than those who had never had any orthodontic treatment.
